1501: ANDY WARHOL - \$ - Dollar Sign

Andy Warhol (American, 1928 - 1987). "\$ - Dollar Sign [black marker drawing on laundry bag]". Black marker drawing on green rip-stop nylon laundry bag. Composed 1982. Signed by Warhol twice, dated, and dedicated to "Liz". Unique. Fine condition with no issues. Literature/catalogue raisonne: See Feldman/Schellmann IIIC.49 (pg. 304) for examples of screenprints on laundry bags. Provenance: Bengtsson Fine Art, Landskrona, Sweden; thence private collection, Paradise Valley, Arizona; thence to our consignor. Overall size: 44 x 27 in. (1118 x 686 mm). Lot Note(s): A unique, classic, and very rare item. Our example is one of only three known original drawings that Warhol executed on a laundry bag, all of the other rare bags bearing silkscreened images. The silkscreened bags themselves have fetched as much as \$193,000 at auction in the past few years. Beginning in the late 1970s, Warhol and his master printer Rupert Jasen Smith worked together to produce a very small number of silkscreens on green laundry bags. The screenprinted images included those of 'Joseph Beuys' and Warhol's celebrated 'Cow.' Our particular example (unused before the drawing) was probably left over from one of these printing sessions, at which time Warhol drew the image and signed it twice, as well as dedicating and dating it. A Chagall gouache and ink drawing on paper, "Maternite avec Pere Noel," similar to our example in composition, medium, date, and dimension, sold for \$275,000 on pre-sale estimates of \$100,000/\$150,000 at Christie's New York, 11/12/2018, lot #149. A Chagall gouache, brush, ink and pencil drawing on paper, "Les amoureux a l'ane bleu," similar to our example in composition, medium, and dimension, sold for \$305,350 (£230,750) on pre-sale estimates of \$105,865/\$158,795 (£80,000/120,000) at Bonhams Bond Street, London, 10/11/2018, lot #15. Chagall, considered one of the foremost artists of the 20th Century, probably painted this work in Saint-Paul-de-Vence, Southeastern France. Picasso, who lived near Chagall during his years in his beloved Côte d'Azur town, once spoke to Francoise Gilot of his palette: "When Matisse dies, Chagall will be the only painter left who understands what color is...His canvases are really painted, not just tossed together. Some of the last things he's done in Vence convince me that there's never been anybody since Renoir who has the feeling for light that Chagall has" (quoted in Francoise Gilot, Life with Picasso, New York, 1989, p. 282). 1504: KARIMA MUYAES - Ancestors

A Letter of Authenticity (LOA) from the Artist accompanies this lot. Overall size: 20 x 31 1/2 in. (508 x 800 mm). Lot Note(s): A widely listed artist, Karima Muyaes is currently one of the most innovative and talented international painters/printmakers working today. A major monograph on her work authored by Avelina Lesper, the foremost contemporary Mexican art critic, was published late in 2023 (available from Stanford Auctioneers, eBay, etc.). Titled "El Color del Espíritu/Color of the Spirit" this 11 x 9 in. (28 x 23 cm) first edition first printing monograph/catalogue raisonne was published in a limited edition of 500 copies. Hardcover in case bound stamped boards with a four color pictorial dust jacket, this long-awaited work is the definitive volume on Muyaes's art. The substantial volume includes nearly 700 images (including hundreds in four color) as well as descriptions of Muyaes's work and is the most complete account of her artistic career to date. In its 396 pages it showcases her figurative and expressionistic work as it has unfolded over the past five decades. Her work has sold at Sotheby's (New York City), Swann Auction Galleries (New York City), Martin Gordon Auctions (Phoenix), Stanford Auctioneers (Phoenix), Louis C. Morton (Mexico City), and Casa de Subastas Odalys (Madrid/Caracas), among others. In April of 2013 and again in 2018 she was chosen by the prestigious Mexican newspaper "Milenio" as one of the top currently active Mexican artists and was featured in a series of newspaper articles and TV appearances. 1505: KEITH HARING - Angry Robot

Keith Haring (American, 1958 - 1990). "Angry Robot". Black marker drawing on paper. Composed 1983. Signed and dated, upper right. Drawn on cream wove paper. Good condition; the work has several issues which conservation, if desired, should successfully resolve: the lower right corner is lacking, apparently with no loss to the image; the center left edge of the sheet bears discoloration and a small paper loss; the upper center edge has one small area of paper loss; a hard crease near the lower right corner, within the image but not affecting a drawn area; scattered mild foxing overall. Provenance: The work comes from the collection of Urbano Quinto (Rhodes, Greece, 1933 – Novara, Italy, 1997) and was acquired directly from Keith Haring in 1983 during the mid-October to mid-November 1983 exhibition of Haring's work at the Robert Fraser Gallery, London. The noted Italian author, art dealer, and art collector Urbano Quinto met Haring in the early 1980s at the Andy Warhol Factory at 33 Union Square West in New York City. Quinto acquired drawings from Pablo Picasso, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Keith Haring, and Andy Warhol, as well as other notable artists, directly from them beginning in the 1950's and continuing through the 1980's. 1507: FRIDA KAHLO - Bandera y fruta

Overall good condition; scattered foxing outside of the image; edge toning; slight bend with no broken fibers, upper left corner; left margin unevenly trimmed. Provenance: The work comes from the collection of Urbano Quinto. It was acquired by Quinto's wife from Pablo Picasso who had acquired it directly from Frida Kahlo. A noted Italian art historian, art dealer, and art collector, Urbano Quinto acquired works from classical artists of the 20th Century as well as Jean-Michel Basquiat, Keith Haring, Andy Warhol, and other Pop and Graffiti artists, often directly from the artists themselves during the 1950's through the 1980's. Lot Note(s): In the last years of her life Kahlo created a series of still life paintings which she considered emblematic of Mexico, foremost of which were her works relating to the Mexican flag, fruits (watermelons, citrus, coconuts, etc.) and the occasional bird or dog. Please see the attached image for a prominent example of these works. Pencil drawings by Kahlo are rare. We were only able to locate nine at auction in the past 25 years. Franz Von Stuck (German, 1863 - 1928). "Bildnis der Tochter Mary mit grünen Bändern". Pastel and pencil chalk on paper. Composed c1912. Signed middle right. Drawn on cream wove paper. Good condition; some staining in the upper right of the sheet, well away from the image, more noticeable verso than recto; minor creasing; handwriting verso; minor foxing; imperfections do not detract from the work. Lot Note(s): This study of the artist's daughter Mary can be compared to a large number of similar works by Franz von Stuck. One of his favorite models, Mary posed for her father in works such as this one, which are personal in nature and notable for their candor, and other more finished works, in which she served as a traditional model, typically dressed in elaborate Spanish or Greek costume. Franz Stuck was a German painter, sculptor, printmaker, and architect. In 1906 he was awarded the Order of Merit of the Bavarian Crown and was henceforth known as Franz Ritter von Stuck. 1512: AMEDEO MODIGLIANI - Caryatid bleue

Amedeo Modigliani (Italian, 1884 - 1920). "Caryatid bleue". Colored wax crayons, charcoal, and pencil drawing on paper. Composed c1912-1914. Hand-signed by Modigliani in pencil, lower right; collector and gallery ink stamps, verso. Drawn on cream wove paper. Condition: overall very good; in the left-side open area between the figure's elbow at the top and thigh at the bottom there is a faint outline in pencil of another Caryatid's face; minor creasing lower left corner; right edge is uneven, the sheet probably removed from a sketchbook; overall the work is quite impressive. Provenance: through the art dealer Léopold Zborowski, his gallery hand stamp verso. Zborowski (1889-1932), a Polish poet, writer and gallerist, was a contemporary of Parisian artists Chaim Soutine, André Derain and Amedeo Modigliani, the latter painting several of Zborowski's portraits. He was Modigliani's primary art dealer and friend during the artist's final years. Zborowski also was the first art dealer of Émile Savitry and Marc Chagall. He accumulated a small fortune as Modigliani's art dealer, tragically losing it during the Great Depression of the 1930s, ultimately dying impoverished in Paris in 1932 of a heart attack. His widow was forced to sell his entire art collection, now completely dispersed. A Letter of Authenticity (LOA) accompanies the work. This drawing, a preparatory sketch for a sculpture, is one of a series of caryatids that Modigliani created between 1912 and 1914. Unlike their classical precursors, which were always draped in long robes, Modigliani's caryatids are nude. The artist referred to them as "columns of tenderness" and planned to incorporate them into an imaginary "temple of beauty." 'Of all the manifestations of Picasso's art throughout his long career, his Cubist collages are among his most inventive and aesthetically original. Picasso, along with Georges Braque, pioneered this artistic movement and introduced the avant-garde to new levels of pictorial abstraction. Still-lifes were usually their favored subjects and never before had this age-old theme been interpreted with such a radical approach. Picasso experimented with the deconstruction and reconstruction of form and the manipulation of space in these compositions, exposing the physical properties of the objects he was depicting. ["Cinzano Vermouth - Asti," executed 1919] is a wonderful rendition of this theme. In this picture, Picasso presents the objects on the table as they would appear from several different vantage points, providing a spectacle that would not otherwise be possible in a two-dimensional representation. During the second decade of the 20th century, Picasso's Cubism developed from fractured, highly abstract "analytical" depictions of form to more legible "synthetic" compositions that incorporated elements of collage. "Cinzano Vermouth - Asti" exemplifies the tenets of this later phase of Cubism.' (paraphrased, with our thanks to Christie's, Paris). 1515: BENJAMIN GREENSTEIN BENNO - Complex Enzyme

Benjamin Greenstein Benno (English/Russian/American, 1901-1980). "Complex Enzyme". Oil on canvas. Composed c1937. Signed lower right. Overall very good to fine condition with no major issues noted (no holes, tears, repairs, flaking, stains, etc.); as found, unconserved, not relined; strong colors. Lot Note(s): Benno was considered a child prodigy and as a youth was enrolled at the Ferrer Center in NYC, a radical school started by Emma Goldman for gifted students. He was taught by Robert Henri and George Bellows, with classmates including Edward Hopper and Man Ray. Pablo Picasso sponsored an exhibition for him during Benno's stay in Paris in the 1930s. Benno's styles included realism, Cubism, still life biomorphic abstraction, abstract art and, eventually, Abstract Expressionism. A significant collection of his works is in the Brooklyn Museum. 

Lot Note(s): 'What's great about this country is that America started the tradition where the richest consumers buy essentially the same things as the poorest. You can be watching TV and see Coca-Cola, and you can know that the President drinks Cokes, Liz Taylor drinks Cokes, and just think, you can drink Coke, too. A Coke is a Coke and no amount of money can get you a better Coke than the one [that] the bum on the corner is drinking. All the Cokes are the same and all the Cokes are good. Liz Taylor knows it, the President knows it, the bum knows it, and you know it.' (A. Warhol, 'The Philosophy of Andy Warhol'). Warhol's 'You're In' personalized the readymade classic Coca-Cola bottle with a lustrous coat of silver spray paint and his characteristic initials emblazoned on the bottle cap. A Pop Art reinterpretation of the Duchampian ready-made is illustrated through the use of a real Coke bottle. It is an icon in the Warholian pantheon of famous names and brands and stands alongside the Campbell's Soup Can and the figures of Elvis Presley and Marilyn Monroe as a quintessential icon of America and the twentieth century. Warhol's fascination with the metalizing of everyday objects began in 1967 with his "silvered bomb." His next collection of silver spray painted objects, done in the same year, was his Coca-Cola bottles. They made their visual premiere on the poster for the Museum of Merchandise for an exhibition produced by The Fine Arts Committee of the Philadelphia YMHA. The poster advertised Warhol's Coca-Cola bottles as being filled with toilet water and mischievously (rakishly?) entitled "You're In." The outwardly shiny and slick bottles were, however, actually filled with "Silver Lining," an inexpensive cologne. By suggesting that the Coke bottle was filled with urine and presenting a cologne that had a cheap scent, Warhol seemed to defame the product that all Americas shared. Coca-Cola, however, was not amused and demanded that their production and sale be halted. This work encapsulates Warhol's profound and unparalleled ability to both retain and destroy the commercial identity of the everyday object [courtesy Phillips, London & Christie's, London].
